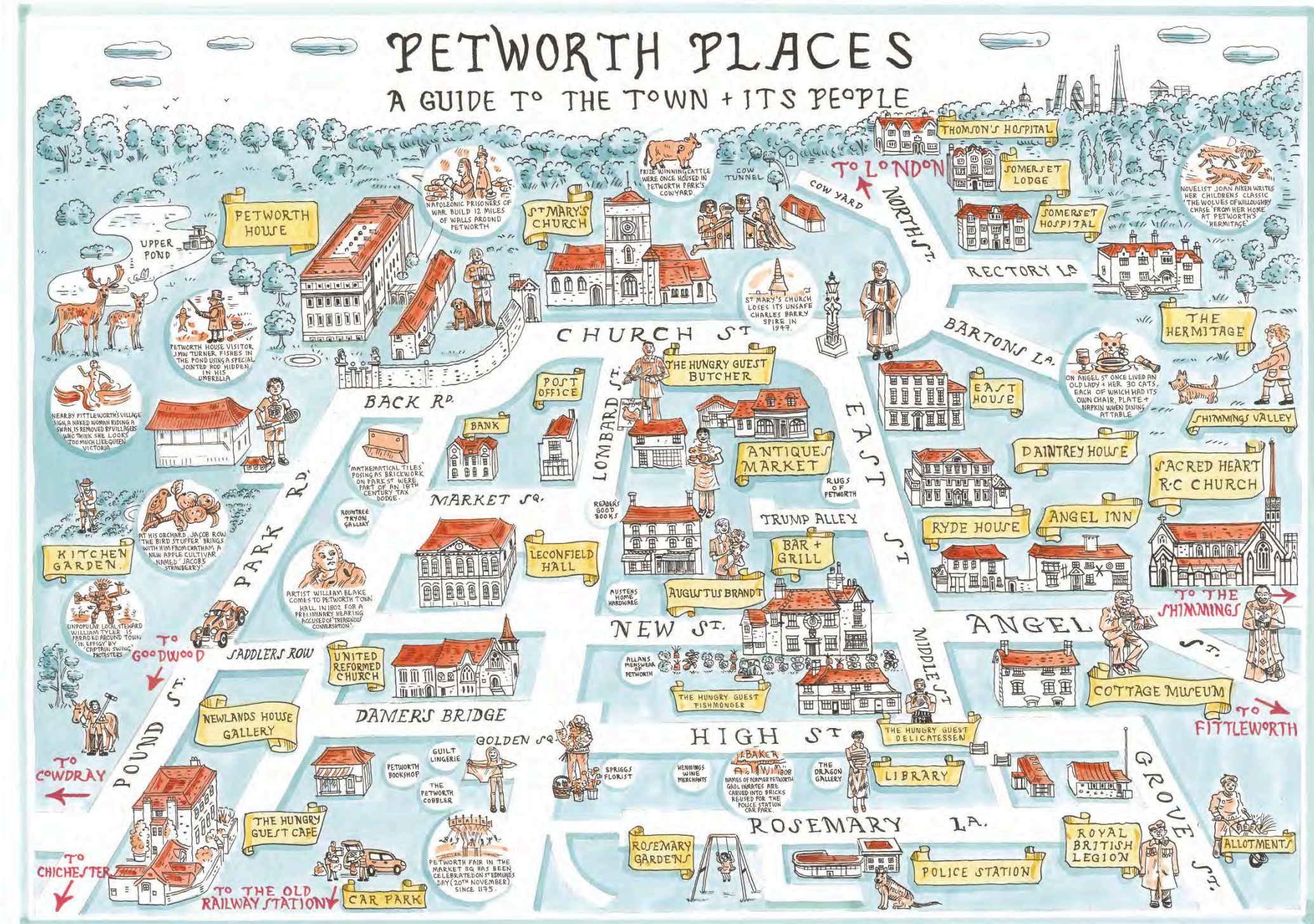
ABOUT PETWORTH



Nestled in the green hills of the South Downs you will find the characterful houses and winding streets of Petworth.

The town of Petworth grew to support the large country estate of Petworth House, now run by the National Trust. Even though we are only an hour from London, Petworth still boasts a slower pace of life as well as an impressive range of cultural entertainment and independent shops.

As a small market town, the whole of Petworth is walkable and there is so much on your doorstep to enjoy. As you leave the ceremony, you can stroll down the famous Lombard Street, or down the lane to the Shimmings Valley for portraits. GETTING READY

The Angel Inn is an historic coaching inn in Petworth with a large outdoor garden ideal for small ceremonies under the Pergola.

Ryde House

Seek the sanctuary of Ryde House, an elegant and understated Regency villa, next door to The Angel Inn and across the road from E. Street.

Our Grade II listed, early 19th century property reflects the sensibilities of the Georgian era, with the perfect balance of charm and character, simplicity and function. It is a serene, comfortable space for any length of stay.

With three double bedrooms, space to entertain, private walled garden and a beautiful kitchen, Ryde House provides the perfect space for getting ready for the ceremony, for family accommodation and even as a honeymoon suite.

EAST HOUSE

East House is a luxury three-bedroom apartment set over the top two storeys of this historic building which is just a short walk from our venues and is opposite St. Mary's Church.

This 18th century building was formerly known as 'The Institute' and acted as a meeting place for local people and reading societies. It has recently been totally renovated and transformed into well-appointed self-catering accommodation.

Enjoy lavishly decorated living spaces and chic bedrooms with stunning details, perfect for a romantic stay before or after the wedding and as a stunning setting for 'getting ready' photos.
